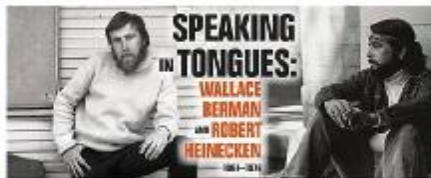


Celebrate Cinco de Mayo with Contemporary Forum in TUCSON

Saturday, May 5, 2012



If you're looking for the latest work by a few of the biggest international names in street and contemporary art, look south, down Interstate 10 past Tucson. It's there, in the "boneyard" of retired aircraft, that you will find a wild, eclectic art exhibit involving 30 artists who have made canvases of five former military planes and plane parts.

The Boneyard Project: Return Trip, our first stop of the day, was organized by Eric Firestone and Brooklyn-based curator and art critic Carlo McCormick. The show boasts an exceptional roster of artists ranging from internationally recognized contemporary artists such as **Richard Prince** and **Kenny Scharf** to well known local artists - **Randy Slack** and **Hector Ruiz**.

After lunch, we will visit the **Center for Creative Photography** for a special tour of: *Speaking in Tongues: Wallace Berman and Robert Heinecken, 1961-1976*. This exhibition examines two seminal, highly original artists, exploring how they bridged modernist and emerging post-modernist trends by ushering in the use of photography as a key element of contemporary avant-garde art. The exhibition first opened in Pasadena, California, as part of 'Pacific Standard Time'.

In the afternoon, we will visit **two artists in their studios** - **Daniel Martin Diaz**, whose work is in the "Boneyard" show; - and long-time Contemporary Forum favorite, **Jim Waid**.

We will wrap up our Tucson visit with a **Cinco de Mayo Happy Hour** before hopping on the bus and heading back to Phoenix. ¡Viva Foro Contemporánea!
